

A MESSAGE FROM RABBI GABI



This week we read Parsha Chayei Sara. I don't know about you, but reading the Parsha gave me a sense of comfort with all the bad news that is going on around us and in Israel.

On one hand, Chayei Sara is dedicated to honouring our matriarch Sara, yet in the first few verses of the Parsha she dies. It teaches us an important lesson on how Judaism views death, where the essence of a person lives on in their Middot and Mitzvot.

Our Matriarch Sara was known for 3 main Mitzvot. From week to week, her bread stayed fresh and her Challah was filling. Her Shabbat candles remained lit from week to week. And the Ananei HaKavod (the clouds of glory), did not disappear from week to week.

When Avraham sent his servant Eliezer to find a wife for Yitzchak, and Rivka our matriarch is brought back to Sara's tent, these 3 signs returned. The challah stayed fresh, the candles stayed lit, and the clouds of glory returned. This showed continuity, and it also showed that the chain of righteous women continued.

More than that, these three Mitzvot symbolized deep connection and faith in G-d.

The reason there is so much emphasis on bread, and its importance, is because creating bread is an incredible feat of hard work and technology mixed with G-d's blessings. The crops must grow in the right time, the rain must water the plants, the harvest requires refining the wheat, the water to bake it. In ancient times, bread required huge amounts of work. So having unlimited fresh bread, from week to week, was a huge blessing.

Likewise, in our electricity-filled world, we forget how difficult it was to maintain light. When night fell, it was pitch black outside. Having wicks and candles were a luxury. Having fire to see by night was not a given. And yet the blessing of Sara included Shabbat candles that remained lit from week to week. Once again demonstrating the tremendous blessing.

The last blessing that Sara had was the clouds of glory, symbolizing G-d's presence.

Most people yearn to feel close to a Higher Source. To recognize that life is not random, and there is deep meaning and purpose to our lives. And having the clouds of glory right there, by the tent, certainly showed that the lives Sara and Avraham were living accorded with G-d's vision for humanity.

As we go into this week's Shabbat, I offer a heartfelt prayer for peace and serenity.

May the Jewish people be blessed to feel the presence of G-d's protection and

an embrace of comfort and security during this difficult time. May we soon celebrate a time in which we can openly see G-d's miracles, which allow us to feel safe and secure along with all the Jewish people, especially those living in Eretz Yisrael.


