

A MESSAGE FROM RABBI GABI



This week, like most Jewish people I've experienced a tremendous roller coaster of emotions as I watched the hostages return home to Israel.

It's been an experience, watching each day as families and children separated

from their parents and siblings make the trek back from Gaza to the Jewish nation. I know the whole country is collectively holding their breath, wondering if the children will make it back as promised.

I know that if I am so deeply affected by this in Australia, many thousands of miles away from the action and drama, that this will indisputably be in the annals of history of the Jewish people. When you live through such a seismic event as this, there is no doubt it has a long-term effect on you. I keep feeling emotional when I think of children locked up and unable to see their parents, and not knowing if they were safe and alive.

And yet, when they return, the joy and relief that sweeps the nation is palpable. The faces of the hostages are so familiar to global Jewry now it is possible that this experience will be one of the most formative for these children. But more so, I feel proud to be part of a nation that since time immemorial has been committed to the safety of all Jewish people. That considers itself incomplete until every single hostage and person is rescued.

When I read this week's Parsha, Vayishlach, it struck me that the Jewish people have always faced adversities. Yaakov reunites with his brother Esav but is unsure if it will be peaceful. The angel wrestles with Yaakov all night and wrenches his hip from the socket. And when he returns from this harrowing encounter, he separates his family to ensure their continued safety.

Being Jewish has always had its challenges, particularly when people wish us harm. But we are also reassured, because G-d watches over the Jewish people. What else can one see when the miraculous return of Israeli children from Gaza other than the hand of G-d's protection?

As we go into Shabbat this week, continue to pray for the safe return of all hostages. Pray that G-d ends the conflict soon. Pray for security and safety in Israel. But most of all, express gratitude that we are here to be able to celebrate the safe return of our brothers and sisters from the depths of tragedy and sadnesss, and to experience the joy of their return.
