A MESSAGE FROM RABBI GABI



As we begin reading Vayikra, the third book of the Torah, known as 'Sefer Hakorbanot' or the Book of Sacrifices, there are descriptions of the different types of sacrifices, the prayers and detailed explanations of how and when.

While the term 'sacrifice' may evoke negative connotations, its Hebrew counterpart 'korbanot' originates from 'kiruv,' meaning 'closeness,' highlighting its purpose of fostering a connection between the person and Hashem.

In biblical times, the size of one's herd and the amount of livestock they owned determined their wealth and social status. Hence, whether atoning for sins or expressing gratitude, individuals sought to bring offerings of value, often in the form of animals. Even those unable to afford whole animals could contribute with sacrifices of flour or oil.

This historical context sheds light on why korbanot remain significant today, despite the cessation of ritual performance for over 2,000 years. The central theme of a korban was for the person to donate and contribute something of value to Hashem, taking time to connect and reflect—a notion that transcends time and remains relevant.

It's easy to feel that sharing what we have is akin to making a korban, a "sacrifice," but we learn from this week's parasha that it actually creates closeness like "kiruv." When we share, whether it's material possessions, time, or compassion, we bridge the gap between ourselves as an individual and the community, fostering bonds of unity and understanding.

Modern findings echo these principles, underscoring the psychological and physiological benefits of altruism. While we don't engage in Korbanot, we can still embody their essence by praying (aka "davening") to Hashem and embracing opportunities to help others daily.

So the next time you get a request for help, especially if it is something that will require patience, effort, and even toil, don't irritably reject it out of hand. Rather, close your eyes, take a deep breath, and ask

yourself, 'is it possible that Hashem has brought this person to me for help, so that I will have the blessing of giving'?


